Specifically, we will evaluate whether the data DoD reports in the Commercial Activities Management Information System under the President's Management Agenda Initiative for the competitive sourcing program are accurate and reliable. We will also review the management control program as it relates to the overall objective. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised audit objectives.

We plan to visit the DoD Competitive Sourcing and Privatization Office. Other DoD organizations and contractor sites to be visited may be identified during the audit.
